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Materials You'll Need

1. Chain 15.
 2. Double crochet in the second chain from the hook and in each remaining chain across. (14 stitches)
 3. Chain 1, turn.
 4. Repeat row 2 until the piece measures approximately 4 inches high or desired size.
 5. Slip stitch in the last stitch of the last row.
1. Place the pocket on the pillow body, aligning the edges.
 2. Single crochet around all four sides of the pocket to secure it.

Part 4: Finishing Touches

1. Embroider or embellish the pillow as desired, such as stitching on a "Tooth Fairy" label or adding ribbon for a decorative touch.

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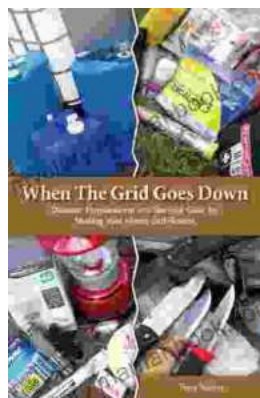
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
