- Worsted weight yarn (approx. 500 yards)
- Size H (5.00mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch
- rep: repeat

Jacket

1. Ch 60.
2. Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (59 sc)
3. Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. (59 sc)
4. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 10 inches from the beginning.
5. Armholes: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 25 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 29 sc. (55 sc)
6. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 15 inches from the beginning.
7. Shoulders: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 10 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 10 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 10 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the remaining 10 sc. (40 sc)
8. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 17 inches from the beginning.
9. Neckline: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 10 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 10 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sl st in the next 10 sc. (20 sc)
10. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 18 inches from the beginning.
11. Sleeves: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the first 25 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 25 sc. (50 sc)
12. Rep rows 2-3 until the sleeves measure 10 inches from the beginning.
13. Bind off all sts.

1. Ch 40.
2. Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (39 sc)
3. Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. (39 sc)
4. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 6 inches from the beginning.
5. Crown: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 19 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 19 sc. (38 sc)
6. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 8 inches from the beginning.
7. Bind off all sts.

Booties

1. Ch 20.
2. Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (19 sc)
3. Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across. (19 sc)
4. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 4 inches from the beginning.

5. Toe: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 9 sc. Ch 1, turn. Sc in the next 9 sc. (18 sc)
6. Rep rows 2-3 until the piece measures 5 inches from the beginning.
7. Bind off all sts.

Sew the side seams of the jacket, hat, and booties. Fold the top of the hat and sew around the edge to create a brim. Add any embellishments desired, such as buttons, ribbons, or flowers.

This crochet pattern bundle is a great way to create a stylish and unique outfit for your little one. 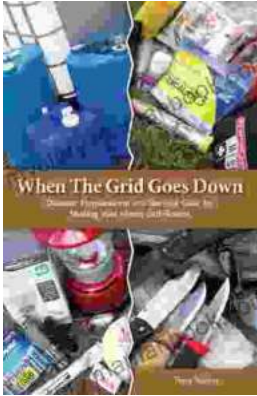


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
