This crochet pattern is for a beautiful baby Moses basket cover blanket afghan in UK terminology. The pattern is easy to follow and the finished product is both practical and stylish.

The blanket is made with a simple granny stitch and is edged with a pretty scallop border. It is the perfect size to fit a standard Moses basket and will keep your little one warm and comfortable.

Materials

- 400g of DK weight yarn in the main colour
- 100g of DK weight yarn in the contrast colour
- 4mm crochet hook

- Tapestry needle

Tension

10 stitches x 10 rows = 10cm x 10cm in granny stitch

Abbreviations

- ch - chain
- dc - double crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- tr - treble crochet

Pattern

Granny stitch:

1. Ch 4, join with a sl st to form a ring.
2. Ch 3 (counts as first tr), 2tr in ring, *ch 2, 3tr in next ch-2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, join with a sl st to top of ch-3.
3. Ch 3, *2tr in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3tr in next ch-2 space; repeat from * 3 more times, join with a sl st to top of ch-3.
4. Repeat Row 3 until the granny stitch is the desired size.

Scallop border:

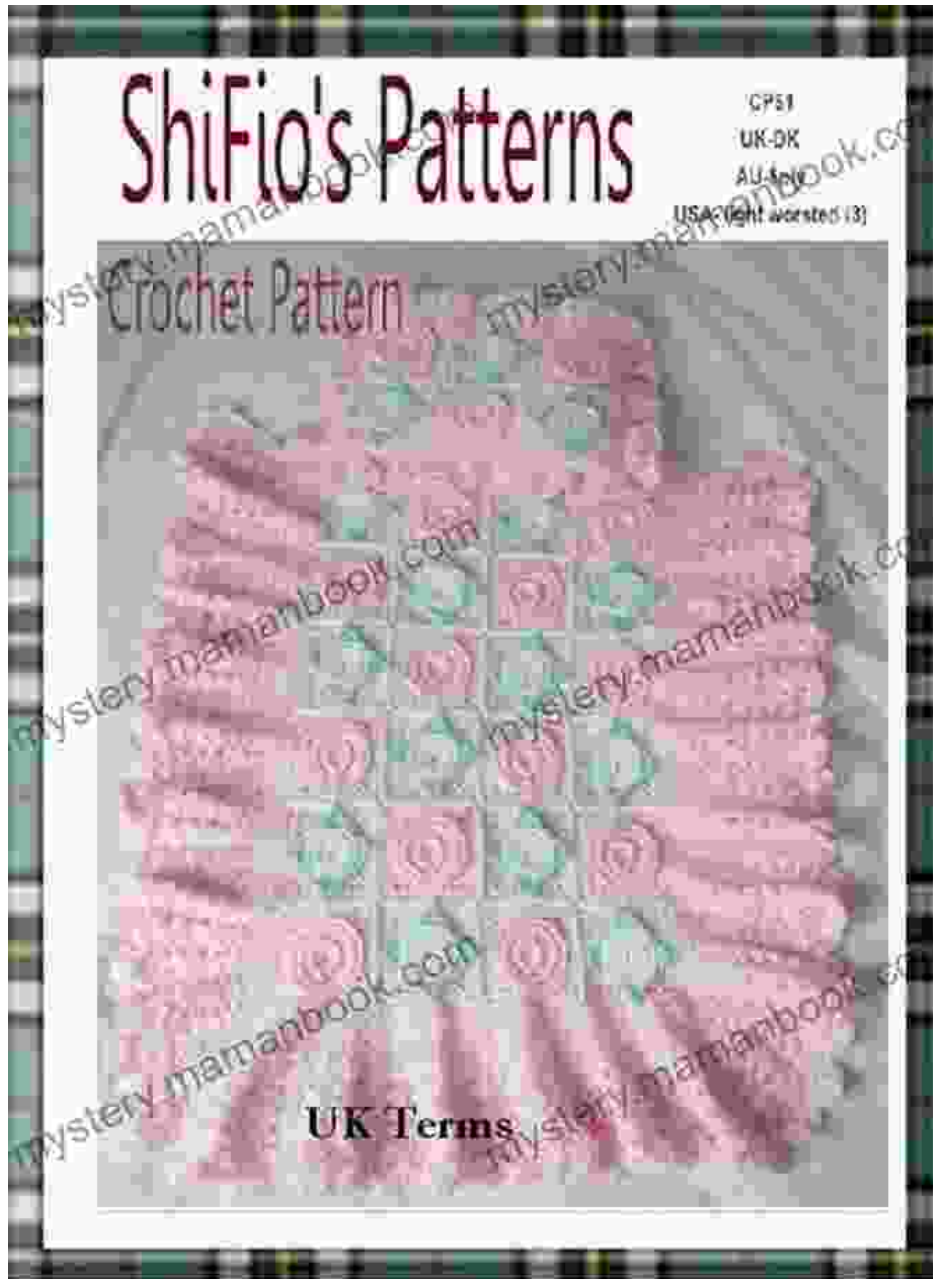
1. Ch 1, *[dc, ch 5, 5tr in next ch-2 space, ch 5, dc] in next ch-2 space; repeat from * around, join with a sl st to first dc.

2. Ch 1, *[3tr in next ch-5 space, ch 5, 3dc in next ch-5 space] in next ch-5 space; repeat from * around, join with a sl st to first tr.

Assembly:

1. Join the granny stitch to the scallop border with a sl st.
2. Weave in any loose ends.

Your baby Moses basket cover blanket afghan is now complete! Enjoy using it to keep your little one warm and comfortable.

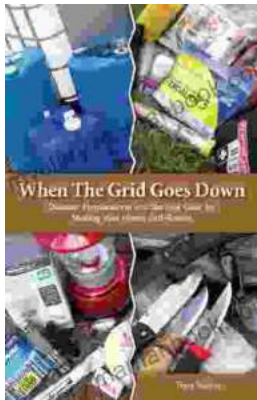
